# History and Mission

The mission of Partnership Against Domestic Violence (PADV) is to support women and their families in their efforts to live violence free.

PADV works to end domestic violence by:

- offering safety and shelter for battered women and their children;
- restoring power, self-sufficiency and control to domestic violence survivors; and
- educating the public on the dynamics of domestic violence.

For over a quarter of a century, PADV, the largest nonprofit domestic violence organization in Georgia, has provided professional, compassionate, caring and empowering support to battered women and their children in metro Atlanta. PADV began as an all-volunteer agency in 1975 and incorporated in 1977. Today the agency has over 40 full and part-time staff with an administrative office in downtown Atlanta and two 24-hour emergency shelters in Fulton and Gwinnett Counties.

## Numbers To Be Proud Of:

- 12,332 calls received on the crisis lines
- 104 women participated in parenting classes
- 2,044 women in the community received support and assistance
- 751 battered women and children were housed in our two emergency shelters
- 20,845 bed-nights provided to battered women and their children  
(Bed-Nights: the number of times our beds were used)
- 348 children participated in our Children & Youth Program

Thursday, July 2002

*Dear Journal,*

Consolata, a Women's Advocate with the Fulton shelter answered the crisis line one evening to a faint "hello" on the other end of the receiver. The caller, a woman, was suicidal. Consolata remained calm, even though her heart was racing a mile a minute. She determined where the caller was on the 'suicidal continuum,' a threat assessment. Showing compassion and support, Consolata persuaded the woman to move away from the gun that she contemplated using. After talking for an hour, the woman trusted Consolata and made a verbal contract with her not to kill herself. She also promised to seek help from one of the PADV referred counseling resources and to call us again if she needed to talk or felt suicidal. Since that initial call, the woman has called back and is no longer suicidal and is working through the issues that led her to her original state of mind. Because of Consolata's calm and professional handling of this volatile situation, another woman's life was saved.

## Emergency Shelter Services and Crisis Line

PADV operates two of the largest emergency shelters for battered women in Georgia. The 41-bed and 32-bed facilities house battered women and children who receive food, clothing, transportation, service coordination and referrals 365 days a year. Professionally trained staff and volunteers field calls on our 24-hour crisis line from women fleeing violence, looking for support and guidance and/or seeking information and referrals.

## Support Groups and Parenting Classes

PADV facilitates support groups for both women and their children. In weekly support groups, women and children are able to share their feelings in a safe and nonjudgmental environment where they find support and encouragement rather than ridicule and blame. Very often, women find it difficult to provide supportive discipline for their children when they are living in a violent relationship. In weekly parenting classes, non-violent disciplinary techniques and methods are discussed and shared among shelter residents, helping them regain this important parenting tool.

Monday, October 2002

*Dear Journal,*

A Kenyan woman and her 10-month-old baby sought shelter with PADV to escape her severely abusive husband. Extremely controlling and physically, sexually and emotionally abusive, he threatened to take their child from her and caused her to lose her job. Abused, homeless, unemployed, and an immigrant with a baby, this woman faced what would seem to most of us insurmountable obstacles. Despite these barriers, this steadfast woman was determined to become self-sufficient and independent. Immediately after moving into our Fulton shelter, she began her job search with her baby strapped onto her back in a traditional ngoi. She also began working through the complex legal issues with Lisa, the Legal Services Coordinator, and attended support group to share her frustrations and fears, but also to impart wisdom and inspiration to the other women and group facilitator. Two months later, she had been rehired by her former employer and found her own apartment. She is legally separated from her abusive husband and has custody of her child. She has traveled a long and difficult road to reclaim her life and rediscover her self-worth. Grateful and appreciative, she calls the Fulton shelter from time to time to share snippets of her new life and her triumphs with staff. In true PADV fashion, it is the Fulton shelter staff who are thankful that they were there to support and witness this incredible woman's journey.

## Community Services

PADV helps women in the community complete legal paperwork and file Temporary Protection Orders (TPO) against their batterers. Staff also provides attorney referrals to women seeking legal counsel. PADV interviews and assesses welfare applicants who show signs of being victims of domestic violence and provides them with service coordination and referrals for community services, employment, and housing opportunities. Victims receive a waiver from certain TANF (welfare) requirements without losing financial assistance and may be re-assessed at regular intervals until the barriers of domestic violence are overcome.

Wednesday, January 2003

## Dear Journal,

Cindy, a Domestic Violence Assessor with the Gwinnett shelter, interviewed a Spanish speaking immigrant who was pregnant, had three children and was on public assistance. She confided that her husband was sexually assaulting her daily in front of their children. She and her children were immediately brought into the shelter. Once safe, Gisela, a Legal Services Coordinator, helped her with a Temporary Protective Order (TPO) which the judge approved. In the TPO the woman was granted occupancy rights to her apartment. Afaf, a Children's Advocate, arranged for her children to attend a community-based counseling program to help them deal with the effects of watching the horrific assaults against their mother. PADV also paid to have locks changed on the apartment to ensure their safety. Despite the sexual trauma, shortly after moving back home this woman gave birth to a healthy baby. She and her children were adopted for the holidays by community supporters who provided them with gifts and happy memories. This story illustrates PADV's effective teamwork that ensures quality delivery of all programs and services.

Saturday, March 2003

## Dear Journal,

A Spanish speaking woman who was nine months pregnant called our Gwinnett county crisis line terrified that she was going to lose her baby because the battering by her abusive husband had escalated. Brought into the Gwinnett shelter that same day, she stayed with PADV for the final month of her pregnancy and had a beautiful, healthy baby girl! The new mother was convinced that had she stayed home one more day, she would have lost her daughter. Soon thereafter, she found a job at a restaurant and an affordable place to live with a new coworker, thereby solving the problem of transportation to and from work. She stayed there for a couple of months, just enough time to save money to relocate to another state. With a fresh start, this new mother now lives with her brother, has support from family and feels safe.

## Fundraising and Community Relations

Despite a war, unemployment and a lagging economy, PADV's revenue is up. Our annual corporate giving was down in FY 2002, so we had to aggressively pursue new corporate partners, foundations and civic organizations. As a result, overall corporate giving is up by 40%, foundation monies are up 42%, and support from civic organizations has increased by 74%.

PADV worked diligently to spread the message about domestic violence and to educate the community about our free and confidential programs and services. We hosted a conference called *When Domestic Violence Goes to Work...Developing A Workplace Response* to help employers understand the impact of domestic violence in the workplace. Other events included the Silent No More Candlelight Vigil with guest speaker Judge Glenda Hatchett, and a Memorial Service for victims of domestic violence to commemorate National Domestic Violence Awareness Month. Sawyer Riley Compton, a branding and ad agency, also designed a new public awareness ad campaign that ran in the Atlanta Journal Constitution and made over six million media impressions. Staff also made improvements in our Volunteer Advocate program.

*Dear Journal,*

Even though domestic violence impacts women from all socio-economic levels, sadly 100% of the women and children we serve in our shelters are economically impoverished and do not have access to basic medical care.

We submitted a grant to the Wellpoint Foundation for \$2,500 and they came back with an amazing \$10,000 gift. Their charitable grant allowed us to address the dental and vision care needs of all the children in shelter in addition to paying for prescription drugs and pediatric visits. The generosity of this community partner helped us provide quality healthcare to children who need it the most.

Tuesday, June 2003

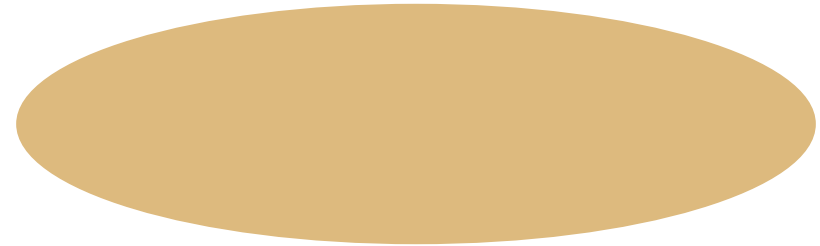

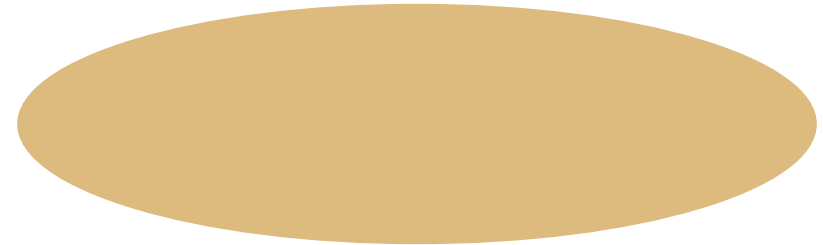

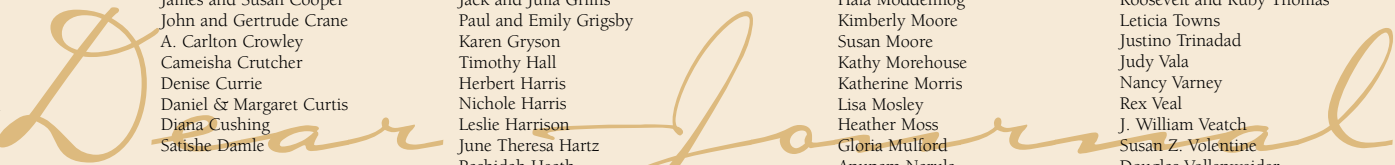
